## **Leesburg High School Band Program Information**

Parent Checklist — many forms (below) will ONLY be available at Parent Orientation Meetings. Go to www.band.caseymanscustomsigns.com then scroll down and click "Registration Form." This is where you'll provide demographic, contact, class, and student information. Register your student and yourself on CutTime (our band account management system). Sign up for the Band App (parents will join Band Parents 22-23, students will join Band 22-23). Attend Parent Orientation Meeting (required for all families) - Pick one of these evenings: July 25th, 26th, 27th at 8:00pm. This is during the marching portion of band camp, so students will be rehearsing at this time. Out of pocket required personal supplies. We try to minimize these as our fundraising pays for nearly everything. As a 501c3 non-profit charity, we cannot fundraise for items a student keeps. # **Time Commitment & Grading Policy**

Our Swarm of Sound Athletic Pep Band performs at Football Games. The Leesburg High School Band is in its 96th season and is the largest student organization on campus. These students represent nearly every organization and athletic team on campus. They are future leaders who experience success by surrounding themselves with other successful and upwardly mobile people.

All Band Members Participate in All Band Activities. Students should expect 2.5 hours of rehearsal each week outside of school. During Football Season, expect Friday night games. All performances will appear on the Calendar on the website and the Band app.

You may have heard that "band takes a lot of time"

This WAS true because of Marching Band.

However, since we don't march competitively anymore, we only have to rehearse one day a week after school.

Students will earn the required Fine Arts Credit upon successful completion of the academic year and the achievement of a C or higher – every student must have this credit to graduate high school.

#### **Grading Policy**

The grading policy here is very simple: Just as in the workplace, a student cannot get "paid" for hours not worked. Similarly, for absences and tardies from band events, students will not receive points. My goal is to help parents raise successful, independent adults. The only problems that ever occur are from ignoring the published calendar, "accidental scheduling mistakes," and assuming that a child deserves an exception because he/she has followed the rules up until that point.

Band members who earn an "A" schedule conflicts on non-rehearsal days. Band is a collective performance group depending on every member to be on time, ready, and committed. Band is important to the students and is a team effort. Students learn very quickly that the performance and image of their band suffers every time a person is missing. They take ownership of their image. They become very motivated to be on time – always ready and present. If they are upset about a scheduling conflict or being late, please support and believe them! We want today's teenagers to show they care about something beyond themselves and our members come to valve their band a great deal.

# Money and Volunteering

Concert Uniform – order on your own or through us – separate payment will be due once the year starts if you go through us. If you purchase it on your own, please email me so we can check you off the list.

Black bowtie, black cummerband, black tux pants with Satin Stripe, Black ¼ inch pleat wing collar tux shirt, black socks, please have by November 1st.

## **EFC (Expected Fundraising Contribution)**

- We have tried to keep this amount to that of an average cell phone bill of our students as well as what we can do
  reasonably in a school year. This is the anticipated amount of fundraising that is necessary to cover participation
  in band activities.


## **Band App Calendar**

#### To export the Band app calendar.


1. Go to the Band app's calendar.

- 5. Click Copy URL


#### To import Band app calendar to iPhone:

- Open your phone's calendar.



- Open Google Chrome on your phone




- Click and hold the "Google Calendar" website link.
